Why a workshop for chamber music?

The workshop will celebrate **15 years of I Cambristi Bruxelles** and the subsequent foundation of two sister organizations, one in France and - very recently - another in Italy. What is more, with Expo 2015, we want to establish a new link between Europe and the largest, most well-established chamber music players association in the world, ACMP.

How the workshop works

The workshop is open to **amateur musicians** of all ages: individuals or already organized groups (minimum 4 people). For all groups, activities are scheduled in 3-hour shifts, of which 90 minutes will be with a **tutor** and the other 90 minutes free for **independent study**.

On Saturday evening after lessons there will be a celebration **party** and a chance to meet with other people and possibly play other pieces in a play-in. Finally, on Sunday the workshop will end with a **concert** open to family and friends.

Each group will be able to **work with four different tutors**, according to the piece they have chosen and the instruments in the group. Lessons will be conducted in English, with translations into Italian, French and German if necessary.

Location

Scuola Musicale di Milano

The Scuola Musicale di Milano was established in October 1891 by a group of Milanese citizens who wanted to provide musical education for their children. Today, it is the **oldest private music institute in Italy**, occupying a special place in Milan's musical culture for 122 years.



Milan - Expo City 2015

Milan is the **musical capital of Italy**. With its theatres, the most famous of which is Teatro alla Scala, it can boast of a very lively cultural life. **Easily reached by air or rail** from all over Europe, it is a great place to spend a weekend of music and good food. 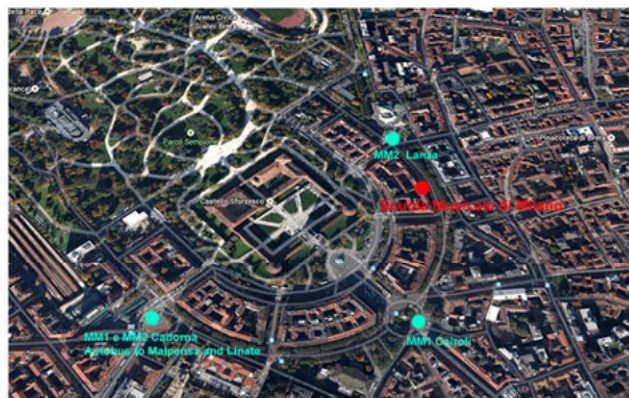


Accommodation, food and drinks

The price of the workshop includes a tea break in the school, sandwiches for the two lunches at the school and a big party to **celebrate** the 15th anniversary of **I Cambristi... with italian food and wine**. Accommodation it's not included: each participant must see to his/her own in the city. Upon request, we can put you in touch with various Bed&Breakfasts or Milan musicians available to host you in their homes.

Transportation

With headquarters in **Foro Buonaparte 60**, the Scuola Musicale di Milano is **in the heart of Milan**. It can easily be reached by the Metropolitana (lines MM 1 and MM 2, Cadorna, Lanza, Cairoli), or from Milan's airports and train stations. That is why it is the **ideal point of departure for a visit** not just to the city centre, but also Expo 2015.



Registration & Costs

Registration fee: **105€** per person if you register by 31 March. 125€ per person if you register later than 31 March. A **discount** of 15€ will be made for all the associates of **Amateur Chamber Music Players** and, of course, **Tutti i Cambristi**.

Registration **includes** the costs of **tutorship**, tea break and **lunches** at the school, participation in the Saturday evening **party**, the final concert and all social activities. Preference will be given to already formed groups. If your group is not complete or if you are a single player looking for a group, we can help you get organized or suggest repertory!
